



12th Grade Checklist

- Keep working on your grades. Make sure you take the courses to graduate in May.
- Continue to participate in extracurricular activities and volunteer activities. Demonstrate initiative, creativity, commitment and leadership in each. (40 hours of volunteer needed in 12th grade for distinguished graduates).
- Register for and take the ACT Assessment, SAT I, or SAT II Subject Tests, as necessary.
- Complete the college application process.
- Fill out the free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and, if necessary, PROFILE(R). These forms can be obtained from the counselor or at <http://www.fafsa.edu.gov> to download the forms or to file electronically. These forms may not be processed before January 1, so don't send them before then.
- Mail or send electronically any remaining applications and financial aid forms before winter break.
- Complete any remaining application procedures.
- March or April expect acceptance letters from universities.
- Present attendance intention by May 1 for university that you will attend.
- Prepare for Graduation.
