

12th Grade Checklist

Keep working on your grades. Make sure you take the courses to graduate in May.
Continue to participate in extracurricular activities and volunteer activities. Demonstrate initiative, creativity, commitment and leadership in each. (40 hours of volunteer needed in 12th grade for distinguished graduates).
Register for and take the ACT Assessment, SAT I, or SAT II Subject Tests, as necessary.
Complete the college application process.
Fill out the free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and, if necessary, PROFILE(R). These forms can be obtained from the counselor or at http://www.fafsa.edu.gov to download the forms or to file electronically. These forms may not be processed before January1, so don't send them before then.
Mail or send electronically any remaining applications and financial aid forms before winter break.
Complete any remaining application procedures.
March or April expect acceptance letters from universities.
Present attendance intention by May 1 for university that you will attend.
Prepare for Graduation.
