Dear Parents and Students- Assalamu Alaikum. Please be advised of the following important procedures for Mid-term Exams.

- Midterm exams will count for 20% of the second marking period average for the 6th-12 grade.
- Time allotted for the exam is 90 min for grades 6-12th. 12th grade AP Calc will be given 120 min.
- Some Midterms are cumulative, covering essential concepts from the 1st and 2nd marking periods.
- All students will receive study guides by Dec. 10, 2018. All study guides will be posted on Sycamore.
- Please remember that these are GUIDES, meaning, that students must go through contextual reading to understand the concepts to be covered on the exams. To increase the probability to excel on the exam, students are required to go over the study guides by writing notes for review and practice immediately upon receiving study guides. Cramming information the night before an exam will not help students understand and retain information on the day of the exam. Remember "inch by inch, is a cinch, yard by yard makes it hard."
- Start the day right! Get to bed early the night before, pray Fajr on time, have a good breakfast and arrive at school early!
- Bring all supplies necessary for the exam i.e. #2 pencils, pens, paper, calculators for high school when allowed, etc.
- There will be more critical thinking and problem-solving questions on the exams. Students are responsible for proper use of punctuation and spelling on all exams. Points will be deducted for incorrect punctuation and spelling.
- In the case of an absence, a note must be sent immediately to the office explaining the absence; if the absence is deemed excused by the administration, the student will be allowed to make-up the exam at full credit.
- No make-up exam will be given without a written, excused absence from the Principal. All make-up exams must be taken within 5 school days of the scheduled exam date or as agreed upon in writing with the administration. No exams will be given after this date, and no report card will be issued before completion of all exams.
