### BHA Tuition and Fees for 2024-2025 School Year

Annual tuition can be paid all at once or in 9 monthly installments.

#### Fees Due Before Start of School Year

- Technology Fee:** \$75/student
- Athletic Fee:** \$60/student
- PSAT Testing Fee** (8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grades): \$20/year
- In-House Testing** (6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> grades): \$15/year
- PTO Membership:** \$10/family
- PTO Volunteer Account:** \$50/semester/family
  - Parents who volunteer 5 hours/semester will receive credit towards next year's volunteer account.

#### Instructional Materials & Resource Fees (annual)

- 1<sup>st</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> grades: \$300
- 11<sup>th</sup> grade BHA textbooks: \$225
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade BHA textbooks: \$150
- Dual credit student textbooks: Fee based on # of credits taken
- 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Art Fee: \$35

#### Specific Fees

- Student Parking Permit** (required for all student drivers who park on campus): \$25/year
- Hot Lunch Program:** \$7/meal
- Late Pick Up:** \$10/day
- Aftercare until 5pm:** \$20/day

#### Other Fees

- Field Trips & After-School Programs vary by activity
- Uniforms vary by item
- School supplies purchases vary

#### Graduation Fees (paid in April)

- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade:** \$75
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade:** \$100
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade:** \$350

### Wakeel Program Overview

The Wakeel Program collects recurring annual contributions from our families, as additional operating funds to help compensate our teachers fairly and invest in our Islamic school. You may choose from two Wakeel Program plans, or choose not to participate in the Wakeel Program.

Contributions are per family and not per student. Contributions can be made in full or in equal monthly installments with tuition.

Participants choosing Plan B, would need to submit tax returns to the FAST (Financial Assistance for School Tuition) committee and would refer to the Annual Household Income table for recommended contributions.

Note: Your financial contribution to support Islamic Education can be considered a donation and is tax deductible and Zakat eligible. ISF is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Our tax ID number is 75-235-2043.

#### PLAN: A

A flat \$1000 per family annual contribution paid in full or equal monthly installments with tuition.

Tax return information is not required for Plan A participation

#### PLAN: B

Annual contribution based on annual household income, reviewed by the ISF Financial Assistance for School Tuition (FAST)

Plan B participants are required to submit supporting documents, such as tax returns and proof of annual incomes
