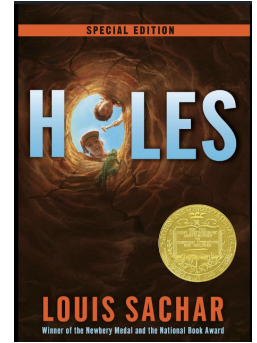
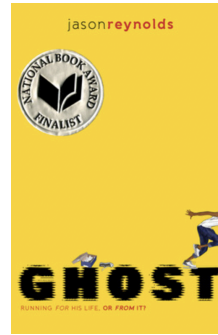
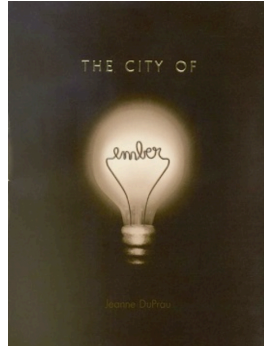
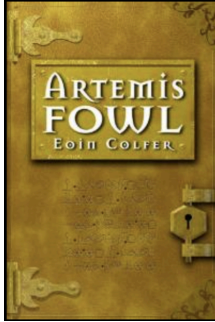


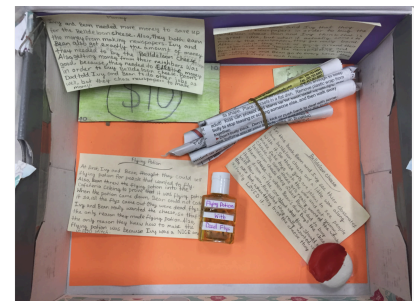
7th Grade Summer Reading Assignment

Assalamu alaikum! For this assignment, you will choose a novel and annotate the entirety of it. While reading, you will pay attention to themes that explore either the price of greatness, justice, or freedom. One or both themes will apply to each book. Your job is to determine which theme, as well provide examples to justify your answer.



For your assignment, you will complete a “book box.” On the outside of the box, you will write the major theme you identified (the price of greatness, justice, or freedom). Inside the box, you will put or create at least 5 items that represent key moments from the book.

On a separate piece of paper typed (Times New Roman, 12 point font), you will create a list of each item you put and write an explanation that analyzes the significance of each item in relation to the book’s chosen theme.
